FOUNDATION STUDENTS

For the first six weeks, Foundation children will attend school on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays during normal school hours. This allows Wednesday to be a rest day.

ATTENDANCE

Bourchier Street Primary School encourages children to attend school every day. If for some reason your child is absent from school, it is requested that you inform the school via the Compass Parent Portal. Please log this absence as early as possible noting a reason for the absence.

It is a Department of Education requirement for all absences to be registered with an explanation.

If your child is late to school (after 9.00am) they must report to front office for the roll to be marked

LUNCH ORDERS USING QKR!

Students to bring a morning recess. For lunch, children may bring their own or order via the

QKR! App from the school which is supplied by the canteen.
Order lunch online using QKR App before 9am on the day.

COMMUNICATION

SEESAW

Bourchier Street uses Seesaw to share and communicate children's learning with families. Children post work on Seesaw for families to view and comment on. This platform can be used to send messages and reminders. Seesaw is private; families will only see posts created by their own child.

Teacher will give you login in details at beginning of year.

COMPASS

Bourchier Street is using Compass School Manager as our parent portal for communication between school and home. Through this portal parents will receive all important information of what is happening in our school.

Login details and instructions are sent home to families after enrolment.

QKR

QKR is an easy way to order school lunches. It also handles all school payments for camps, excursions, parent payments and you can also order school hats and jackets via QKR app and they will be sent to classroom.



SICK BAY

If your child is sick or injured he/she may be taken to the Sick Bay for treatment. You will be notified and requested to take your child home if he/she is not well enough to return to the classroom. Sick children will be supervised in the Sick Bay.

SUN SMART

Children are required to wear a broad brimmed hat when outside during Term One and Term Four. This included recess and lunch breaks, Physical Education sessions and Excursions. Children without hats need to play in the shade.

PARENT PAYMENTS & EXCURSION LEVY

Parent payment covers stationary that is in classroom at beginning of year and allows us to deliver quality programs and learning experiences.

Excursion Levy covers incursions and whole school events inside and out of the school.

Swimming is covered by government.

Parent Payments can change from year to year.

If you have a Health Care Card, you can claim CSEF and receive a \$125 credit for each child.

2024 Parent Payment is \$220 and
excursion levy \$80 Total being \$300.00 per student.

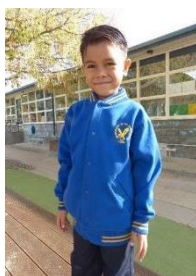
SCHOOL UNIFORM

BASIC BELIEFS
